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# Checklist for teachers: How do I implement the b@s videochallenge at my school?

Time frame
$\square$ Find a time frame for the project, such as project days or a week of regular classes.
Technical
<ul> <li>□ Are students allowed to film their video with their phones or does the school have a camera?</li> <li>□ Is there a computer room or can the students edit their videos at home?</li> <li>□ Which students already have experience creating videos and can help the others?</li> </ul>
Preparation
Introduce the assignment and the four companies along with their prizes to the students and set the schedule.
Point out the rules of participation to the students (participant consent forms, data privacy statement, and terms and conditions of use) and explain how to deal with copyright (infographic). Hand out the consent forms for signing and send the original signed forms to us. Alternatively, the students can send in or upload their own consent forms individually.
Execution
